# Powerful Disaster Recovery with No Environmental or Operational Impact

### **Overview**

University of Louisville Physicians is the largest, multispecialty physician practice in the Louisville area. UofL Physicians' nationally renowned physicians care for all ages and stages of life, from pediatrics to geriatrics. They all are professors and researchers at the UofL School of Medicine, teaching tomorrow's physicians, leading research in medical advancements and bringing the most progressive, state-of-the-art health care to every patient. For greater efficiencies, UofL Physicians leveraged best practices to build their state of the art data center which included building a virtualized infrastructure, and now it needed to be protected. The one requirement they had was the business continuity and disaster recovery solution could not interfere with the current processes and needed to support aggressive service levels.

UofL Physicians evaluated an array-based solution, EMC RecoverPoint, and a backup-based solution, Veeam, before selecting Zerto Virtual Replication. One of the key reasons they virtualized their IT infrastructure was to leverage the flexibility it offers. With an array-based solution that flexibility is gone. Storage VMotion and VMotion could no longer be used and as their environment is constantly evolving, this was not an option. They needed the flexibility to ensure their operations would not be impacted. A backup-based solution was also evaluated, however, the snapshotting took too much power away from the applications and they were unable to get the aggressive recovery point objectives they needed for their environment. Veeam was great for their backups, just not suited for their replication needs. Zerto Virtual Replication delivered the aggressive recovery point objectives (RPOs) and recovery time objectives (RTOs) they need without requiring any operational changes. UofL Physicians could continue to use VMotion and Storage VMotion as needed and their current operations, processes and procedures would not be impacted.

### The Problem

Uofl Physicians needed a BC/DR solution that would install seamlessly into their existing environment without impacting their existing processes. Their IT environment was designed very quickly, with the understanding that through virtualization, they would have a highly mobile, flexible environment. The BC/DR strategy needed to support the flexibility and agility they required. They could not use a solution which required the environment to remain fixed.

Adding another layer of complexity is that the performance and integrity of the applications cannot be compromised. The IT environment is handling patient data, which is highly regulated in terms of privacy, accessibility, and retention. The environment

- Microsoft SharePoint 2010
- AllScripts Electronic Health Records application
- GE Centricity Business
- Impact
- VMware vCenter
- Various Financing for Accounting Accounts Receivable and Payable 574 GB

If any of these applications were unavailable or running slow, patient care could be affected. Some applications, such as AllScripts, have a direct effect on patient care.
